

**HSK LEVEL 3****Program Length:**

175 classroom hours (7 weeks) - when transitioning from level 2 HSK or equivalent Chinese level  
393 classroom hours (17 weeks) - from beginner level

**Learning Outcome:**

A working vocabulary of around 1,500 Chinese words - knowledge of more complex Chinese sentence patterns and grammatical structures - ability to read graded reading materials - increased conversational fluency - high level 3 HSK test pass

**Class Structure:****Integrated Skills 70hrs**

Our Integrated skills class focuses on developing your overall base in spoken Chinese, listening comprehension, reading, writing and grammatical structures. Class content and materials are taken directly from the prescribed HSK curriculum and weekly practice tests are conducted to assess your progress and ensure you are on track to pass the test.

**Targeted Practice 70hrs**

When preparing for the HSK test it is important to ensure that each aspect of your Mandarin (speaking, listening, reading and writing) is progressing at an even rate; Targeted practice addresses this and provides language exercises specifically tailored to focus on any weak points in your language abilities. During targeted practice sessions language points are reviewed, analyzed to ensure comprehension and then expanded upon with the guidance of your teacher. Targeted practice plays a very important part in the success of our HSK-Track program and is one of the key reasons why Konall Culture Exchange students' regularly outperform students who have studied at other schools.

**Listening Focus 21hrs**

Level 3 continues on from level 2 with an increased focus on listening comprehension in preparation for longer listening passages and more complex and challenging questions in the HSK test. Listening focus sessions combine real exercises taken from past HSK tests with intensive sentence pattern, listening comprehension and dialogue drills provided by your instructor.

**Grammar Focus 14hrs**

Level 3 sees the introduction of focused grammar sessions to prepare you for the increasingly challenging grammar and reading sections of the HSK test. More complex structures are explained in detail and broken down using example questions commonly found in the test.
